Communities Along the Territorial Corridor

Alvadore

A lvadore is an unincorporated farming community at the north end of the Territorial Corridor. The town was originally formed around a branch of an early railroad and named for Alvadore Welch, who built the Portland, Eugene, and Eastern Railroad through the community. The post office was established in 1914.

Besides the post office, the community is served by a library, a volunteer fire department, a church and several businesses.

With the Fern Ridge Reservoir Dam and Orchard Point Park within a mile of Alvadore, it's not surprising that boating and fishing are two of

the most popular recreational activities. The town was originally formed around a branch of an early railroad.

Cheshire

A ccording to Oregon Geographic Names, Cheshire was a station on the Southern Pacific Railroad line platted in 1913 and originally named Hubert. This name caused confusion with another station on the line, Huber, however, so the railroad company changed the name to Cheshire in 1914. The Cheshire post office was established the same year. Both "Hubert" and "Cheshire" were names chosen to honor James Hubert Cheshire, a favorite child of the people in the area.

Cheshire is an unincorporated community sitting at the northern-most border of Lane County. It's most notable landmarks feature a DariMart convenience store and a post office serving the 97419 zip code.

Crow

The small unincorporated community of Crow, Oregon, located approximately 4 miles southeast of Veneta in Lane County, was first settled in the early 1850s following the passage of the Donation Land Act of 1850. It was named after either one of its original settlers, Andrew Jackson Crow, or his son James A.J. Crow. There are conflicting accounts. The Crow Post Office was established on November 6, 1874, but it was closed on November 15, 1938.



The community has an elementary school, a combination middle/high school, a grange, a church, a store/deli and two mechanic shops.

Elmira

Elmira is an unincorporated community in Lane County, Oregon. It is located west of Eugene and north of Veneta and Oregon Route 126, near the Long Tom River and Fern Ridge Reservoir.

The community was named after Elmira, California, after previously having the name "Duckworth".[1] A local business owner persuaded postal authorities to rename the community "Elmira" in 1884.

In 1905, Elmira Road & surrounding area was homesteaded by Henry & Celia Faulhaber along with their children Leon, Neal & Mildred. Sometime between 1905-1916 Elmira Road was donated back to the county by Henry Faulhaber and later renamed Faulhaber Road.

Franklin

Franklin, also referred to as Smithfield, is an unincorporated rural community located near the northern end of the Territorial Corridor. The post office was established in 1855, closed in 1902, and was reestablished as Smithfield. A controversy ensued and in 1943, it was referred to as both Franklin and Smithfield. Today, it is now known as Franklin, Oregon.

The community no longer has a post office, but supports two churches.

Lorane

Lorane is an unincorporated rural community at the south end of the Territorial Corridor. Lorane was named by the wife of its first postmaster in 1887, in honor of a favorite niece.

In addition to the post office, the community is served by a fire department, a Rebekah/Theta Rho lodge, a grange, a church and several businesses including three major wineries.

Each year, the community celebrates through their Lorane Ice Cream Social, the Lorane Old-Timers' Picnic, Chateau Lorane's Art in the Vineyard and various Holiday Bazaars during the holidays.

Today the Lorane area is home to award-winning wineries, talented local artists and classic bed and breakfasts.


Noti

Toti is an unincorporated community in Lane County, Oregon, United States, located in the foothills of the Central Oregon Coast Range between Eugene and Florence. Per the 2000 census, Noti had a total population of 699.

Noti post office was established in 1913, when the name was changed from Portola. The postmaster was H.G. Suttle.

In 2002, Noti Grade School, a landmark built in 1927 and known as "The Little Blue School", was closed. It was formerly located directly on

Oregon Route 126, but after a highway realignment project in 1996 the school is now located on a quiet road called the "Noti Loop Road", and the highway passes just north of and behind the school.

Veneta

Tncorporated in 1962, the City of Veneta is a thriving community of ▲ nearly 5,000 people. The City of Veneta is located 12 miles west of the Eugene/Springfield Metropolitan Area, in the southwest corner of the beautiful Willamette Valley in Lane County, Oregon. Located at about 420 feet above sea level, the city receives between 45-50 inches of precipitation a year. It is home to an area of many wineries. Veneta is located in close proximity to the Fern Ridge Reservoir - a great place for birding, sailing, and canoeing activities, and is only 45 miles from the Pacific Ocean and 90 miles from the scenic Cascade Mountains. Veneta



is also the home of the Fern Ridge Public Library that serves people residing within the Fern Ridge School District boundaries.

Veneta was established in 1912 by Edward Eugene Hunter, who named the settlement after his five year-old daughter. In 1982, Veneta Orilla Hunter Vincent attended the city's 70th anniversary party, and she passed away in 2000 at the age of 93. Compliments of http://en.wikipedia.org

Walton

7 alton is an unincorporated community in Lane County, Oregon. It I located halfway between Eugene and Florence on Oregon Route 126.

Construction of Route 126 began in 1881, and after it crossed the Oregon Coast Range near Noti, it followed a tributary of the Siuslaw River named Walton Creek. Walton post office was established in 1884 to serve the settlers along the new route and postmaster James L. Atkinson named it for the stream. The stream was in turn named for Joshua J. Walton, a pioneer lawyer who served as a county judge and regent for the University of Oregon. At the beginning of the 20th century, the stream's name was changed to Wildcat Creek.







Applegate Pioneer Museum

Begun on March 25, 1973, the museum was first sited in Crow, Oregon on property donated by Bob & Gary Mikkelson, owners of the Crow Market and Mercantile. The Spencer Creek Lutheran Church donated the former Pine Grove School as a building. It was moved to the site behind the store and the Grand Opening took place during the Fall Festival held at Crow on September 11 & 12, 1976.

In 1999, neighboring Veneta city officials offered to host the museum within its city limits. The city offered to lease to the museum a corner lot at 7th and Broadway streets for \$1 per year. They arranged to pay for all permits and two-thirds of the cost of the move. It was an offer the museum board could not resist, bringing the museum closer to a denser population which would help support it with not only additional memberships, but with volunteers, as well. The move to Veneta took place in 2000 and it re-opened in 2001.

Volunteers, donations and memberships generated by the bi-monthly newsletters on local history provide the support needed to keep the Applegate Pioneer Museum operating.


